- Applicants must be an active member of IHOA.
- Applicants must be applying and planning to attend college as a full-time student in the school year following the award.
- Applicant must graduate from high school no later than June of the award year.
- Academic standing, including but not limited to grades, class rank, standardized tests scores and curriculum.
